- Carving begins Wednesday, July 18 at 10:00 a.m. and ends on Saturday, July 21 at 4 p.m.
- Quick Carves will be at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday and Saturday evenings. All Quick Carves will take place by your carving station and we will have cones and barriers to keep people back from you while you're carving.
- Carvings must be completed by 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, July 21st. The general public will then vote for their favorite carving from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. Winners will be announced after the quick carve on 7/21.

FAQS FOR FREDERICK CHAINSAWS & CHUCKWAGONS CARVING COMPETITION:

- Will I be compensated for competing?
 - The Town will provide each carver with \$200 at the start of the competition for Show-up/gas money and you have the ability to win prize money as follows:
 - 1st Place: \$2,000
 - 2nd Place: \$1,500
 - 3rd Place: \$1,000
 - Carver's Choice: \$500
 - Winners will be determined by public vote from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. at the end of the event on July 21st. This event is for Frederick residents so we let them pick the carvings they like best! There is also a Carver's Choice where we will have a secret ballot for each carver to pick their favorite carving.
- Where will the carving take place?
 - Along Main Street in Downtown Frederick between Fourth St. and Fifth St. next to Crist Park (105 5th Street, Frederick CO 80530).
- Will there be quick Carves?
 - Yes! Thursday and Saturday nights at 6pm. All carvers are strongly encouraged to participate. These are timed hour long quick carves followed by an auction. The Town will keep half the money to help cover costs of the event and the carver will keep half the money.
- Where will I stay?
 - The Town will book a block of rooms at a nearby hotel for carvers to stay from 7/18-7/22; all carvers must check out on Sunday, July 22nd and any additional charges accrued will be the carver's responsibility. The Town will pay for your room, but each carver will have to put a card on file at the hotel to cover any incidental charges. We will update all participating carvers on the location of the hotel as the event draws near.
- Will we be fed?
 - Of course! We will provide lunch and dinner for each carver (plus one) as well as beverages and snacks while you're busy carving away.
- What's happening Saturday?
 - Saturday, July 21st will be filled with fun kid's activities, live music, food trucks, and of course the presentation of the winner of the Chainsaw & Chuckwagons Carving Competition! This portion of the event will take place at Crist Park, next to the carving competition location
- What equipment/supplies will the Town be providing?
 - The Town will provide professional scaffolding, chainsaw oil and gas, generators, as well as folks to help clean up!
- May I sell merchandise and other carvings?
 - Absolutely! You can display carvings throughout the event. On Thursday evening, there will be a farmer's market that will draw people to the park. We will also have entertainment on Friday evening and Saturday afternoon!
