**FREDERICK, Colorado (11/26/2025)** - On November 25, 2025, at approximately 6:25 pm, the Frederick Police Department was notified of a suspect vehicle that had reportedly fled from a disturbance that had just occurred in the Town of Firestone.

The suspect vehicle, a white Toyota Tacoma pickup, was located in the Town of Frederick, traveling westbound on Highway 52. When Frederick officers attempted to contact the driver, the vehicle initially stopped. Before the officer could make contact, the driver accelerated away from the traffic stop, made a U-turn, and rammed the patrol vehicle, striking the driver's side door. The suspect, Andrew Jarmillo, age 26, exited the vehicle and fled on foot into the nearby field before he was taken into custody for the following criminal charges:

- Attempt Murder of a Peace Officer
- Criminal Attempt
- Resist arrest-creating risk of bodily injury to officer
- Vehicular Eluding
- Failed to yield at intersection
- Criminal Mischief

Under Colorado law, the arrest and filing of criminal charges are merely formal accusations that an individual committed a crime.

Mr. Jarmillo was transported to a hospital for evaluation and, once medically cleared, to the Weld County jail. The involved officer was also transported to an area hospital to be evaluated for minor injuries.
