Agilent Technologies Facility Expansion in Frederick

FREDERICK, Colorado (January 9, 2023) - Agilent Technologies

The Town of Frederick is excited to share that during the JP Morgan Healthcare Conference on January 9, 2023, Agilent Technologies, Inc. announced a major expansion to their Frederick, CO campus. This announcement came at the conclusion of a national site selection process that began in the first quarter of 2022.

“Agilent’s presence in Colorado is an important element of our focus on supporting high-growth businesses and the customers we serve,” said Mike McMullen, Agilent president and CEO. “The resources, talent, and support we have in the state have helped, and will continue to help us achieve our long-term growth objectives. We’re very pleased to be expanding our manufacturing operations in Fredrick and look forward to continuing our role as a positive force in the community.”

Details of the project were provided at the Town of Frederick's Urban Renewal Authority meeting on December 13, 2022. The project includes additional manufacturing space across two new buildings connected by a breezeway. This expansion is anticipated to create 160 new jobs at an average salary that exceeds \$100,000 per year. Agilent's plans for this expansion, which will stand on land they own, are estimated close to \$725,000,000. The project is expected to take three years to complete.

Agilent engaged in a similar site selection process in 2016, which resulted in Frederick being the top choice to locate a new manufacturing and research & development facility. Agilent has since continued to make investments to attract talent, acquire new equipment, and build out its facilities in Frederick.

"The Town has remained committed to fostering a business climate that cultivates a lasting relationship with the business community," said Ryan Johnson, Assistant Town Manager.

Projects of this scale can only happen when partnering with other agencies across the State. In addition to local incentives offered, Weld County and the State of Colorado have pledged incentives for this project. All incentives are performance-based, using revenues created by Agilent as the funding stream.

“The Town of Frederick is a rapidly growing community in Colorado,” said Tracie Crites, Town Mayor. “We continue to prioritize Economic vitality by bringing businesses of all sizes to our Town. We are honored that Agilent recognized the talent pipeline and solid infrastructure offered in the Town of Frederick. We congratulate Agilent for their success and celebrate that they are continuing to choose Frederick!” Since 2021, the Mayor and Board have maintained a vision that prioritizes community and economic vitality for Frederick in their adopted Strategic Plan. This includes fostering a variety of economic opportunities that enhances the quality of life in Frederick while preserving the small-town feel and rich heritage that are the foundation of the community.
