19th Judicial District Investigates Police Shooting Death in Frederick, CO

Frederick, CO – On 1/5/23 at approximately 11:30pm, officers of the Frederick Police Department responded to the 200 block of 7th Street to an incident involving suspected shots fired. Upon arrival, responding officers and a resident came under gunfire from a residence in the area. Multiple agencies responded to assist, including the Firestone Police Department, Mead Police Department, and Weld County Sheriff's Office. During the incident officers fired at an adult male suspect who was struck and pronounced dead at the scene.

Officers or members of the public were not injured and no motive in this case is known at this time. There is no threat to the public. Access to the area of the scene will be limited and the public is being asked to avoid the immediate area.

The 19th Judicial District Critical Incident Response Team (CIRT) has responded to lead the investigation. The Weld County Coroner's Office is not naming the subject at this time but will provide that information at a later time.
