


We've Heard from YOU



The Town of Frederick administered a community survey to better understand how the Town's transportation system is working for **YOU** and what concerns you have. We received approximately **350** responses. **97%** of respondents live in Frederick. Below is a summary of what you said.

Key themes from the survey:
