

In the **FIRST** community survey for the **TRANSPORTATION MASTER PLAN**



YOU told us about Frederick's transportation system; what is working and what concerns you have. A follow-up survey, administered by the Town of Frederick, asked you to tell us about **YOUR VISION** for the **FUTURE** of our transportation system. We received approximately **250 responses** and below is a summary of what you said.

YOUR Vision for the KEY Plan Themes:

"Right-sized" Streets



- Pedestrian friendly infrastructure
- Keep the current "hometown" feel of the community
- Accommodate more bikes and pedestrians
- Inviting with trees and landscaping



FUNDAMENTAL to **ALL** future transportation investments



You Said...

- Parks and Open Space and Downtown Frederick are the two **most important** activity centers
- Downtown Frederick, Commercial areas, and Transit centers are the hardest activity centers to get to

With an adequate network, **64%** of the community would switch to a non-vehicle form of transportation to access parks. **43%** would switch to access community events.



Focus on Carbon Valley transit options



DOWNTOWN

- Inviting & relaxing space that **encourages** community gatherings
- Outdoor space for pedestrian use



- Keep traffic flowing, but do not over-build
- Provide dedicated turn lanes
- Safe sidewalks for pedestrians
