This permit authorizes the moving of the oversize/overweight vehicle and/or load described over the route outlined on the date and time noted. Deviations from the dimensions of the described vehicle and/or load, for the route, from the conditions, or from the provisions, and exclusions set forth in the statutes, rules and regulations respecting oversize vehicles and loads as stated in the Colorado Revised Statutes and Town of Frederick Municipal Code render this permit null and void. This permit must be carried in the vehicle, or combination of vehicles to which it refers, and shall be open to inspection by any police officer or authorized agent. If the requested permit is granted, the permittee agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Town of Frederick, its officers and employees, its appointed and all elected officials, from all suits, actions, or claims of any character arising from the issuance or use of this permit.

Oversize / Overweight Vehicle Information

Town of Frederick, Colorado

Additional categories and fees might apply; refer to Sec. 8 of the Town of Frederick Municipal Code for further information. Applicants are responsible for knowing and observing the rules and regulations contained in the Town of Frederick Municipal Code.

Oversize / Overweight Vehicle Limits:

Vehicles that have any dimension exceeding these limitations will require an Oversize / Overweight Permit.

Length: Single unit is 45'
Semitrailer is 57'4"
Saddlemounts (4 unit maximum) is 75'

Overhang Length: Front is 4'
Rear is 10'

Width: Total is 8'6"

Height: Total is 13'

Vehicles whose weight exceeds these limitations will require an Oversize / Overweight Permit.

Single axle shall not exceed 20,000 pounds.

Two Axle / Single Unit: 36,000 pounds

Three or More Axles / Single Unit: 54,000 pounds

Oversize / Overweight Vehicle Fees:

For oversized / overweight vehicles which do not exceed 200,000 pounds:

- (a) Annual Permit, \$250.00
- (b) Daily Permit, \$100.00
- (c) Single Trip Permit, \$15.00
- (d) Annual Fleet Permit, \$1500.00 plus \$15.00 per fleet vehicle

For overweight vehicles over 200,000 pounds:

- (a) Single Trip Permit, \$125.00 or actual cost to the Town of the extraordinary action, whichever is greater. In addition, unless waived by the Town Engineer or their designee for good cause, a bond in the amount the Town Engineer or their designee determines shall be provided to the Town. The minimum bond shall be \$2500.00 as security for damage to streets or Town property.

Note: If using Colorado State Highways, Weld County Highways or other jurisdiction's road/streets applicant must apply for those permits separately with the appropriate agency.
